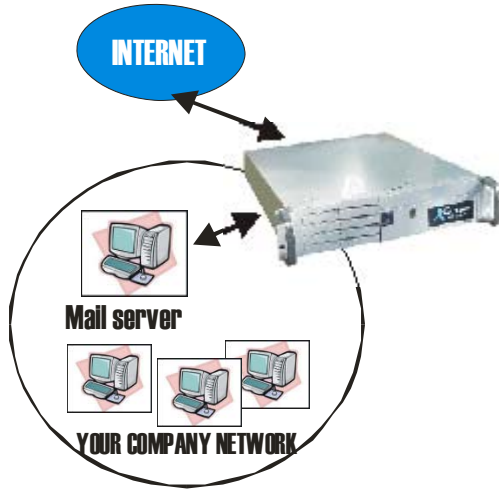

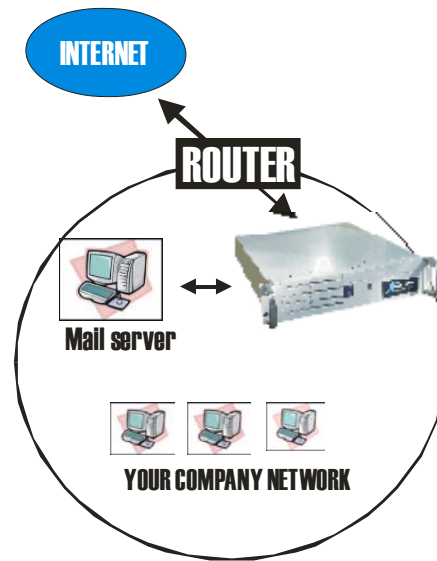

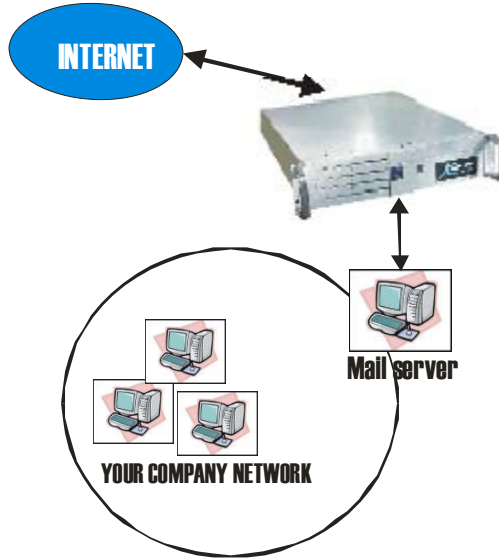
Figure 1 – XwallBox Placement



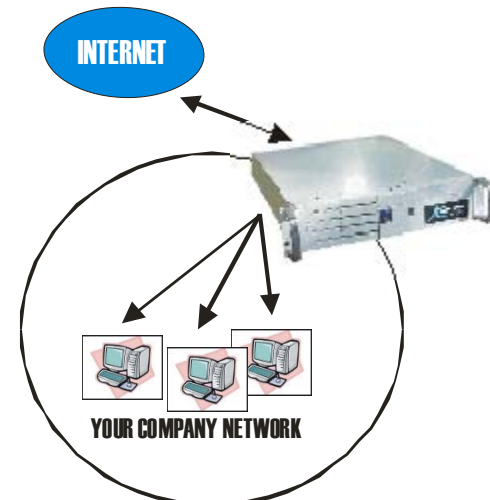
**Scenario A: XWALLBOX with 2 Network cards and providing SMTP firewall services**
